**TECHNICAL LICENCE EXAMINATION SCHEDULE FOR PILOTS AND  
AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE ENGINEERS**

1. The Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority has experienced frequent requests from Pilots wishing to take examinations outside the published schedule of once a month. This has been difficult for our planning and sometimes also caused inconveniences to the applicants, operators and the examiners.
2. The Authority has therefore found it necessary to increase the frequency of all technical examinations to fulfill the demand. As from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2000, examinations for Pilots will be available on weekly basis on every Thursday. In order to facilitate the examiners in preparing the examinations according to requests, the applicants should submit applications for examinations latest Friday, for exams to be taken the following Thursday.
3. In case of a failure, unless specified otherwise, the minimum period for the Pilot to re-sit the examination will be two weeks from the last sitting.
4. The Authority will try as far as possible to issue results within seven working days from the date of the examination.
5. The Aircraft Maintenance Engineers' written license examinations will now be taken monthly, on the last Thursday of the month to coincide with the pilots' examination. Applications for such examinations shall be forwarded well in advance for evaluation and advise on the sitting date.
6. Oral examination schedule will remain as it is, that is every Tuesday and Wednesday.
7. Other conditions of these examinations shall remain as published in relevant guidance material e.g. Airworthiness Notices etc.
